

It is Called "PASSWORD" For A Reason



Sometimes our only defense to protect our sensitive information is our password. While it is a pain sometimes, it is worth the extra few seconds it takes to make your password strong. Here are some tips:

- 1. Stay away from using proper nouns, dictionary words, or ordered sequences. Even with common letter substitutions (like @ for "a", for example) passwords are easy to crack.
- 2. Length is more important than complexity. Simply put, the longer your password is, the more time it will take to figure it out.
- 3. Use substitutions that are unexpected. "Oranges" is very easy, "Or@nges" is slightly better, "Or@nge5" is a little better, but a random character inserted is even better, like "Or_ang\$eshe".
- 4. Use the least common of the special characters. Characters such as] " $\{$ } ~ are less common than = + -?. Using two uncommon ones can really increase the difficulty.
- 5. Remember to mix up the upper and lower case letters.
- 6. Often, using a phrase instead of some personal information is good. For example, your phone number, house number, pet's name and zip code would be easy, but to say "My Hair is 8loNd!" is pretty secure.
- 7. One of the biggest no-no's we do is to write down our passwords. If you have a program that doesn't require a change, you are less likely to write it down. If it isn't required, don't make a change.
- 8. Probably the worst thing we can do is what most of us do: We use the same password for multiple accounts. Never use the same password on multiple accounts, even if you think it is a really strong code. The security of the password goes down quickly when you use it for more than one login. With just one code broken, you could be opening up your Amazon account, your PayPal account and your bank account to hackers.
